BULLSBLAST 2021

GENERAL EVENT INFORMATION:

This is the 14th Annual Bulls Blast supporting USF Athletics and the Linda and Randy Simmons Athletic Scholarship Fund.

Shooting Period: 10 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. All scoring sheets must be turned in by 1:00 p.m. to be included in the awards scoring – No Exceptions. Please be mindful of the need to finish on time and pace yourself accordingly.

Lunch and Presentation: At 12:30 p.m. we will sound a 30 minute air horn warning and begin serving lunch. A brief program, awards ceremony, and final raffle drawing will be held between 1:00 – 2:00 p.m.

Course Assignments: Four Courses will be available. Each team will be assigned a starting station and will rotate through 7 stations in numerical order. Example: You may be assigned to start on #3. Your next stops are 4 to 7, then 1 & 2. Please do not take the stations out of order as it will result in congestion and slow shooting.

Scoring Rules: Each team consists of 4 shooters. If your team only has 3 shooters, then each team member will rotate shooting the 4th slot and record his or her score on the 4th scorecard. USF coaches and other celebrities will be assigned to specific stations throughout the course. The coach/celebrity will act as a 5th shooter on that station. If the coach/celebrity has a higher score than one of the four team members, the coach's score will be used in lieu of the lowest score. Only the highest 4 scores on each station will be included in the final score tabulation. See scorecards for more detailed information. Each team member is to score a maximum of 50 shots. Each shooter will receive one complimentary mulligan (2 shots) for a maximum of 52 shots taken, but only the best 50 are counted in the final score.

Assigned Golf Carts: A clipboard with your team name on it will be placed on the seat of your cart to help you identify your assigned cart. The clipboard will contain scorecards for each team member. The scorecards will identify your team's starting course and station number. Each team member's name should be written on a scorecard before commencing shooting.

Ammunition and Shot limitation: Each shooter will receive 50 rounds of either 12 gauge or 20 gauge ammunition and one complimentary mulligan (2 shots). If you require a different type of ammunition, you are to provide your own ammunition. Celebrity shooters will have their own ammunition but may ask to utilize a gun from one of your team members if they do not have their own gun. Should there be a malfunction of a machine the celebrity/shooter will provide replacement ammunition. Only TBSC personnel are authorized to address malfunctioning equipment; they will be rotating around the course to assist with any such matter.

Please help us stay on schedule by adhering to the 50 shot maximum rule. Adhering to this request also maximizes scholarship proceeds, as TBSC charges by the clays shot. Even if you are using your own ammunition, shooters taking extra shots slow down the speed of the course rotation and delay the event.

Course Assistance: Should you need assistance while on the course, please seek out a volunteer wearing an **EVENT STAFF** vest. They will be in golf carts roaming each course to assist with questions, directions, provide additional shells, etc. Additionally, TBSC staff will be rotating around the course to provide assistance.

SHOOTER CHECK IN:

Shooter Check in is between 8:00 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. Stop at the Waiver Tent located at the northwest corner of the parking area, review safety instructions and waiver forms, sign a waiver, and proceed with signed waiver to the Registration Tent. Turn in signed waiver to receive wristband. Wristband color will correspond to the course color to which you are assigned. The wristband entitles the wearer to enjoy breakfast and lunch and participate in the shoot.

After check-in, shooters proceed to the Armory to receive shells goody bag, eye and ear protection.

Raffle tickets can be purchased at the Sales Tent. The suggested donation for raffle tickets is \$60 per ticket or 2 for \$100. We have a generous number of raffle prizes, including three shotguns. We will draw raffle tickets during the shoot and post results under the pavilion between 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. Please check the postings when you return from the course. If your ticket is not posted. do not throw it away, as we will draw for the three guns and other major prizes after lunch in a live drawing.

MISCELLANEOUS EVENT INFORMATION:

Shooting 101 classes offered between 8:05 a.m. - 8:30 a.m. and between 8:40 a.m. - 9:10 a.m. Both classes are targeted to beginners and inexperienced clay shooters. Simply go to the designated area to be included in the class.

9:35 a.m. - Shooters return to golf carts for a mandatory safety talk beginning at 9:40 a.m.

All gun rentals must be coordinated directly with Tampa Bay Sporting Clays by calling 813-929-6200 at least the day before the event. We strongly suggest reserving a gun several days in advance to ensure that one is available for you. There may be a limited number of rentals available the day of the event.

A number of specialty vendors will be on hand for the event. We encourage you to visit with them.

If you or your guests have any special dietary restrictions, please let us know at least 72 hours prior to the event.

Attire: Shorts, khakis or jeans and a USF logo shirt with sneakers or other closed toed shoes suitable for wearing in the woods. Please keep in mind the weather and bring a jacket or raincoat, if necessary.
